Wolseley Hall has been the ancestoral home of the Wolseley family since Anglo-Saxon times until the death of Sir Edric in 1954. The title passed to the eleventh Baronet, Sir Charles Wolseley our Patron and descendant of Frederick York Wolseley whose name was given to "our cars".

Previous members of the family living at the Hall were keen garden enthusiasts with gardens of some note. Sir Charles shares that keen interest. Wolseley Hall no longer exists, and Sir Charles recently returned to the locality to dedicate his life to the redevelopment of the grounds, being highly involved with the recreation of past concepts and the development of new ideas. The first phase of development is now completed on five gardens, the centre piece being the walled rose garden covering some two acres. It is intended there be some sixteen gardens ultimately. Sir Charles' aims for Wolseley Garden Park are not only to provide employment, but also "tourism, educational, scientific, horticultural and spiritual benefits".

The Official Opening will be by Mr. Edmund de Rothschild on Tuesday, the 1st May 1990 for which the Register has been invited to provide a display of 50 cars spanning the 80 years of the Marque's production. Those cars of Veteran, Vintage and early Post Vintage periods, and those models having specialist or factory special coachwork will be of particular welcome. This suggested display does not preclude cars of the later periods. It is hoped to have some representation from the Hornet Special Register present.

You are invited to attend this function with your car(s) and I hope you are able to do so. Your support would be most welcome to provide Sir Charles a 'day to remember'.

Cars should arrive and be in position by no later than 10.30 hrs on the day in readiness for proceedings to commence at 11.00 hrs. Selected cars will form part of the cavalcade. Wolseley Register insurance arrangements will apply for this Byent not to be missed, and which will be widely covered by the media and open to the public in the afternoon.

Those wishing to display their car(s) should complete the tear-off slip (for more than one vehicle use reverse side) and return to the Hon. Secretary by no later than the 31st March.
